
The Texas Transportation Commission (commission) approved the Fiscal Year (FY) 2006 Federal Discretionary Program by passing Minute Order 110542 on May 25, 2006.

On September 5, 2006, the Texas Department of Transportation received notification from the Federal Railroad Administration that \$379,985 was made available for the elimination of highway-railroad grade crossing hazards on the high-speed rail corridor designated by the United States Congress as the South Central High Speed Rail Corridor. The funds were made available for highway-railroad crossings in the city limits of Fort Worth. These funds were provided under Section 104(d)(2) of Title 23, United States Code, as amended by Section 1103(f) of the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the commission that the FY 2006 Federal Discretionary Program is hereby amended to include highway-railroad grade crossing improvements on the federally designated high speed rail corridor in the city of Fort Worth at an amount not to exceed \$379,985.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the executive director is hereby authorized to proceed in the most feasible and economical manner with project development and program monitoring of these projects.
