
In ARANSAS COUNTY (county) in the City of Rockport (city) city officials have requested that a segment of STATE HIGHWAY LOOP 70 be removed from the state highway system and returned to the city for control, jurisdiction, and maintenance. In order to maintain continuity on the state highway system a segment of FARM TO MARKET ROAD 1069 will be redesignated on the state highway system as an extension of SH Loop 70.

Pursuant to Texas Transportation Code, §§201.103 and 221.001, the executive director has recommended that a segment of SH Loop 70 be removed from the state highway system and a segment of FM 1069 be redesignated as an extension of SH Loop 70.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Texas Transportation Commission that:

1. A segment of STATE HIGHWAY LOOP 70 be removed from the state highway system and returned to the city for control, jurisdiction, and maintenance from the intersection of FARM TO MARKET ROAD 1069 eastward and northward to the intersection of STATE HIGHWAY BUSINESS 35 L, a distance of approximately 0.75 mile.
2. A segment of FARM TO MARKET ROAD 1069 is redesignated on the state highway system as an extension of STATE HIGHWAY LOOP 70 from its present terminus at the intersection of STATE HIGHWAY LOOP 70 westward to its new terminus at the intersection of STATE HIGHWAY BUSINESS 35 L, a distance of approximately 0.35 mile.


