
Minute Order 91219, dated January 29, 1991, tendered a proposal to the City of El Paso and El Paso County to relocate a portion of STATE HIGHWAY LOOP 375 and stated that the city would provide 100 percent of all right of way costs for the proposed project.

Since 1991, categories of funding and the criteria for project selection have changed substantially and as a result, the Unified Transportation Program was restructured to reflect those changes. Under current policy, it is permissible to use Category 7, Metropolitan Mobility and Rehabilitation funds for the purpose of right of way acquisition.


The El Paso District recommends rescinding Minute Order 91219. This will allow flexibility for right-of-way acquisition, including the use of Category 7, Metropolitan Mobility and Rehabilitation funds for the proposed project.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the commission that Minute Order 91219 is rescinded.
