In DALLAM COUNTY, officials have requested that two new state highway spur designations be added to the state highway system. The proposed new locations would serve as an alternate route connecting US 87, US 385, and US 54. To facilitate the flow of traffic, promote public safety, and maintain continuity of the state highway system the county has requested the following:


1. A new location be designated as STATE HIGHWAY SPUR 17 from a point near the intersection of FM 1727 at US 87, eastward to a point north of Dalhart at US 385, a distance of approximately 1.97 miles.
2. A new location be designated as STATE HIGHWAY SPUR 24 from a point north of Dalhart at US 385, eastward to a point near the intersection of Noble Road at US 54, a distance of approximately 1.95 miles.

Pursuant to Texas Transportation Code, §§201.103 and 221.001, the executive director has recommended that two new state highway spur locations be designated on the state highway system as State Highway Spur 17 and State Highway Spur 24.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED by the Texas Transportation Commission that:


1. A new location is designated as STATE HIGHWAY SPUR 17 from a point near the intersection of FM 1727 at US 87 eastward to a point north of Dalhart at US 385, a distance of approximately 1.97 miles.
2. A new location is designated as STATE HIGHWAY SPUR 24 from a point north of Dalhart at US 385, eastward to a point near the intersection of Noble Road at US 54, a distance of approximately 1.95 miles.
