

**NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE
IH 35 FRONTAGE ROAD PROJECT**

On Thursday, May 28, 2009, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct an Open House to present plans for the proposed improvements to Interstate Highway (IH) 35 frontage roads from Farm-to-Market Road (FM) 2001 to County Road (CR) 210, a distance of approximately 3 miles. The Open House will be held in the City of Buda's city council chambers between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. at 121 Main Street, Buda Texas. The proposed improvements would consist of the conversion of the frontage roads from two-way to one-way directions of travel.

A layout of the proposed project and typical sections of IH 35 frontage roads will be displayed at the Open House, and will be available for review between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday prior to the Open House at the TxDOT South Travis Area Office (9725 S IH 35, Austin, Texas 78744). A formal presentation will not be made during the Open House, but those wishing to attend are encouraged to do so at their convenience anytime between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 8:00 p.m. During the Open House, project team members will be available to answer questions.

The Open House will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the Open House who require auxiliary aids or services, such as interpreters, are requested to contact Ms. Shelly Eason, Environmental Specialist (512) 832-7001, at least two business days prior to the Open House so that appropriate arrangements may be made. TxDOT will make every reasonable effort to accommodate other communication or accessibility needs.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Open House and provide input on the project. Verbal and written comments may be presented at the Open House.
