



NOTICE OF OPEN HOUSE
PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF AN EXTENSION TO
ROBERT S. LIGHT BLVD. (BUDA TRUCK BYPASS)
FROM: FM 967 at Robert S. Light Blvd.
TO: FM 1626

On Thursday, March 20, 2014, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Hays County, in partnership with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) will conduct an Open House for the proposed construction of an extension to Robert S. Light Blvd. from FM 967 to FM 1626 in Hays County, Texas. The Open House will be held at Elm Grove Elementary School, 801 W FM 1626, Buda, Texas 78610 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

The proposed project would be constructed on new location and include acquisition of additional right of way for an ultimate 4-lane divided section and construction of an interim 2-lane extension of Robert S. Light Blvd. from FM 967 to FM 1626, a distance of approximately 1.8 miles. The proposed project is included in the Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) 2035 Plan. The purpose of the project is to provide an alternative route for truck traffic bypassing downtown Buda thereby enhancing safety and improving mobility within the project area.

The purpose of the Open House is to share project information with the public and to obtain public input to be considered during development of the project. A No Build alternative and a Build alternative are being considered for the proposed project. Maps, drawings, and other information depicting the proposed project location and preliminary design will be available for review at the Open House. Prior to the Open House, this information will be available for review at the Hays County Precinct 2 Office (5488 FM 2770 Kyle, Texas 78640) and at the TxDOT South Travis Area Office (9725 S IH 35, Austin, Texas 78744). A formal presentation will not be made during the Open House, but project team members will be available to answer questions.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Open House to provide input on the project. Verbal and written comments regarding the proposed project are requested and may be presented either at the Open House or in writing after the Open House. To be included in the official record of the Open House, written comments must be received by 5:00 PM on Monday, March 31, 2014. The Open House will be conducted in English, but a Spanish interpreter will be available.
