**Notice of Open House for Improvements to RM 620 in Williamson County
From Cornerwood Drive to Wyoming Springs Drive**

The public is invited to an Open House on Thursday, May 6, 2010 presenting proposed improvements to RM 620 from Cornerwood Drive to Wyoming Springs Drive, a distance of approximately 2.0 miles. The Open House will be held at the Brushy Creek MUD Community Center located at 16318 Great Oaks Drive, Round Rock, Texas from 6 pm to 8 pm. Williamson County, in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), will conduct the open house to gather public input and comments for the project.

The proposed improvements would include widening the portion of RM 620 from Cornerwood Drive to Wyoming Springs Drive to a four-lane roadway with two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, 14-foot shoulders with curb and gutter, and a raised center median. Left and right turn lanes, culverts, water quality facilities, and retaining walls are also proposed.

The Open House will be informal, and attendees are encouraged to come and go as they please between 6 pm and 8 pm; there will be no formal presentation. Project maps, exhibits, and handouts will be available for review and comment. Representatives from Williamson County and their consultant and TxDOT will be present to answer questions about the project.

The purpose of the proposed improvements is to enhance safety within the project area. Approximately 13 acres of additional right of way would be needed to construct the proposed improvements, the majority of which is proposed to be acquired from the southeast side of RM 620. There would be no displacements of residences or businesses as a result of the proposed improvements.

Preliminary maps and exhibits of the project will be on display at the Open House, and are currently available for review at the Williamson County Road and Bridge Office located at 3151 S.E. Inner Loop, Georgetown, Texas and at the TxDOT Georgetown Area Engineer's Office located at 2727 S. Austin Avenue, Georgetown, Texas.

The Open House will be conducted in English. Persons interested in attending the Open House who require auxiliary aids or services, such as interpreters, are requested to contact Connie Watson, Williamson County, Public Information Officer, telephone (512) 943-1663, fax (512) 943-1662, or email cwatson@wilco.org at least five business days prior to the Open House so that appropriate arrangements may be made. Williamson County and TxDOT will



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make every reasonable effort to accommodate communication or accessibility needs.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend the Open House and provide input on the project. Verbal and written comments may be presented at the Open House.
