

Pursuant to Transportation Code, §21.111, and Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, §30.209, the Texas Department of Transportation will conduct a public hearing to receive comments from interested parties concerning financial assistance of \$50,000 per grant per eligible airport under the Routine Airport Maintenance Program (RAMP) and proposed approval of financial assistance at the following locations: City of Beaumont, City Castroville, City of Center, Cherokee County, City of Galveston, City of Granbury, Grayson County (North Texas Regional Airport-Sherman/Denison), Harrison County, City of McGregor, City of McKinney, City of Monahans, City of Plainview and Hale County, City of Rockwall, and Texas State Technical College- Waco.

The public hearing will be held on Thursday, July 23, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. at 150 East Riverside, South Tower, 5th Floor Conference Room 107, Austin, Texas 78704. Any interested person may appear and offer comments, either orally or in writing; however, questioning of those making presentations will be reserved exclusively to the presiding officer as may be necessary to ensure a complete record. While any person with pertinent comments will be granted an opportunity to present them during the course of the hearing, the presiding officer reserves the right to restrict testimony in terms of time and repetitive content. Organizations, associations, or groups are encouraged to present their commonly held views, and same or similar comments, through a representative member where possible.
