




DISTRICT PROFILE

The Childress District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in the following counties: Briscoe, Childress, Collingsworth, Cottle, Dickens, Donley, Foard, Hall, Hardeman, King, Knox, Motley and Wheeler.

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- US 287 in Childress and Hardeman counties: rehab of existing roadway (concrete repair) - \$9.9 million
- US 83 in Wheeler County: Super 2 from Wheeler to the Hemphill County line - \$9.8 million
- US 83 in Wheeler County: Super 2 from Shamrock to Wheeler - \$9.0 million
- FM 1547 in Collingsworth County: roadway widening - \$6.1 million

PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:

- SH 6 in Hardeman County: rehab of existing roadway - \$5.3 million (Sept. 2016)
- US 62/83 in Childress County: rehab of existing roadway - \$5.3 million (Sept. 2016)
- US 287 in Hardeman County: rehab of existing roadway - \$4.3 million (Sept. 2016)
- I-40 in Wheeler County: bridge replacement - \$3.8 million (March 2017)

MAINTENANCE: The Childress District has an operating budget of \$15.9 million and a contract budget of \$5 million. Annually, we spend \$1 million on mowing, \$1 million on seal coat, \$500,000 on crack seal, \$1 million on striping, \$550,000 for bridge maintenance, \$500,000 for safety upgrades (guard fence ends) and \$500,000 on miscellaneous improvements.

CORRIDORS: The Childress District's priority corridor effort is the rural portion of I-40, US 287, US 83 and US 82.

SAFETY: The Childress District has several projects scheduled to rehab and widen existing roadways in Wheeler County that have been affected by the energy sector growth. Centerline rumble strip have been added in various locations to aid in preventing head-on collisions to enhance motorist safety.
