GENERAL NOTES

GENERAL

Vulcan construction Materials, LLC, the Contractor and the Railroad Company shall coordinate their work schedule.

The disturbed area in this project, all project locations in the Contract, and the Contractor project specific locations (PSLs), within 1 mile of the project limits, for the Contract will further establish the authorization requirements for storm water discharges. The Department will obtain an authorization to discharge storm water from the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) for the construction activities shown on the plans. The Contractor is to obtain any required authorization from the TCEQ for any Contractor PSLs for construction support activities on or off ROW. When the total area disturbed for all projects in the Contract and PSLs within 1 mile of the project limits exceeds 5 acres, provide a copy of the Contractor NOI for PSLs on the ROW to the Engineer (to the appropriate MS4 operator when on an off-state system route).

ITEM 8 PROSECUTION AND PROGRESS

Working days will be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.1.4 "Standard Workweek".

Work shall not be performed without time being charged.

ITEM 104 REMOVING CONCRETE

Concrete (riprap) removal has been estimated at 180 sy and shall be used to remove any existing riprap that interferes with the installation of the crashwalls or as directed by the Engineer.

ITEM 334 HOT-MIX COLD-LAID ASPHALT CONCRETE PAVEMENT

HMCL ACP is estimated at 5 tons for this project.

ITEM 403 TEMPORARY SPECIAL SHORING

Temporary Special Shoring has been estimated at 1200 sf for this project.

ITEM 420 CONCRETE SUBSTRUCTURES

½" bituminous material shall be required as a bond breaker between the crashwall and any other concrete, unless otherwise directed by the Engineer. This material will not be paid for directly but shall be considered subsidiary to the crashwall item(s).

ITEM 421 HYDRAULIC CEMENT CONCRETE

Furnish dome lids with 4" x 8" cylinder test molds.

Strength testing equipment is not required for Contract controlling test.

ITEM 427 SURFACE FINISHES FOR CONCRETE

An "Off-the-Form-Finish" as defined in 427.4.3.4 will be required on the crash walls.

ITEM 502 BARRICADES, SIGNS, AND TRAFFIC HANDLING

The Contractor Force Account "Safety Contingency" that has been established for this project is intended to be utilized for work zone enhancements, to improve the effectiveness of the Traffic Control Plan, that could not be foreseen in the project planning and design stage. These enhancements will be mutually agreed upon by the Engineer and the Contractor's Responsible Person based on weekly or more frequent traffic management reviews on the project. The Engineer may choose to use existing bid items if it does not slow the implementation of enhancement.

All equipment operated by the Contractor on or within thirty feet (30') of the roadway shall have a functioning flashing beacon mounted on it. Motor graders shall have two standard orange warning flags mounted on them in addition to the flashing beacon.

ITEM 506 TEMPORARY EROSION, SEDIMENTATION, AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONTROLS

Stockpile sites may be cleared of cover vegetation, but the vegetation root system shall not be destroyed.

The SW3P for this project shall consist of using Contractor Force Account or Agreed Unit Price if erosion control is deemed necessary and shall be as directed by the Engineer.

ITEM 644 SMALL ROADSIDE SIGN ASSEMBLIES

Build signs not detailed in the plans according to the latest edition of the Standard Highway Sign Designs for Texas.

Conformable Retroreflective Sheeting in accordance with DMS 8300 will be required on all Warning, Stop, and Yield signs. Retroreflective sheeting wrapped around a sign support is yellow unless the sign on the support is a Stop or Yield, in which case the sheeting shall be red. Retroreflective sheeting shall have a height on the post of 12 inches and the bottom of the sheeting shall be 4 feet above the edge of the travel lane. Retroreflective sheeting will not be paid for directly but shall be considered subsidiary to Item 644 Small Roadside Sign Assemblies.

ITEM 666 RETROREFLECTORIZED PAVEMENT MARKINGS

A mobile retroreflectometer is not required for this project.
