This contract consists of performing litter removal in the Bexar 410 Maintenance Section.

Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own, and as such, is separate from other contracts. A contractor awarded multiple contracts must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

There are locations within the contract limits that are under construction on another contract. Work will not be done at these locations and payment will not be made for the acres where litter is not removed. When construction is completed work will resume and payment will be made accordingly.

Notify the Engineer's office by telephone each morning by 8:15 a.m. that work is scheduled, with work location and time of arrival or reason for not working that day.

Workers exposed to traffic will be attired in bright, highly visible clothing at all times. A highly visible reflective vest will be acceptable.

Item 8 “Prosecution and Progress”

Working days will be computed and charged in accordance with Article 8.3.A.4 Standard Workweek. Work hours will be daylight hours unless otherwise approved.

Item 502 “Barricades, Signs, and Traffic Handling”

Furnish and install all signs, barricades and other incidentals necessary for proper traffic control, in accordance with part VI of the “Texas Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways” and as directed. All warning signs shall be factory made and in satisfactory condition.

Use CW20-1D "Road Work Ahead" sign mounted on a portable support. Move signs as necessary to maintain the same relative spacing between the signs and the work area as work progresses along the roadway. Place signs as indicated on RS-TCP-04.

Traffic control will be subsidiary to the various bid items.

Item 734 “Litter Removal”

The Department will issue a written notice to begin the initial litter cycle. Successive cycles will be scheduled as follows.

Perform a cycle for Tracts 1 through 9 beginning on the first day of the month or the first working day thereafter. Complete this cycle within 7 working days.

Perform a second cycle for Tracts 1 through 4 beginning on the fifteenth day of the month or the first working day thereafter. Complete this cycle within 4 working days.

Once work has started on a cycle, proceed in an expeditious manner until all work on that cycle is satisfactorily completed. Liquidated damages will be assessed for any working day charged beyond the authorized time. Time will not be charged between cycles.

Whole tires picked up from the right-of-way may be disposed of at the Maintenance Section Yard at the locations designated below:
