 CATIONS FOR THIS PROJECT.

SPECIAL SPECIFICATION**6511****Refurbished Raised Reflective Pavement Markers**

- 1. Description.** Remove and replace the reflective faces of Plowable Reflectorized Pavement Markers Type I-A, Type I-C, Type I-R, Type II-A-A, Type II-A-R, and Type II-C-R for Item 672, "Raised Pavement Markers".
- 2. Materials.** Furnish raised pavement marker reflective faces meeting the applicable requirements of Departmental Material Specifications for Pavement Markers (Plowable Reflectorized) DMS-4210 of the Type specified above. Verify in the field the replacement reflective faces are compatible with existing raised pavement marker bodies.
- 3. Sampling.** The Engineer will sample in accordance with Test Method TEX-729- I.
- 4. Construction.** Each reflective face must be of the same manufacturer. Remove the reflective faces from the body of the pavement marker by a suitable means that will not affect the body adhesion to the pavement surface. Clean the area of the body to which the reflective faces will be applied by sand blasting any excess adhesive residue from the existing raised pavement marker body, ensuring this area to be free of rust, scale, dirt, oil, grease, old adhesive or contaminants which might adversely affect the adhesive face. Use an adhesive as recommended by the manufacturer in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations to bond the reflective face(s) to the body of the existing reflective pavement marker. Apply the adhesive in sufficient quantity to adhere 100% of the bonding area of the reflector to the body of the pavement marker. No excess adhesive will be allowed to interfere with the reflective surface of the marker. Ambient temperature shall be 60°F or above.
- 5. Measurement.** This Item will be measured by each raised pavement marker refurbished. This is a plans quantity measurement Item. The quantity to be paid is the quantity shown in the proposal, unless modified by Article 9.2 "Plans Quantity Measurement." Additional measurements or calculations will be made if adjustments are required.
- 6. Payment.** The work performed and materials furnished in accordance with this Item and measured as provided under "Measurement" will be paid for at the unit price bid for "Refurbish Raised Pavement Markers". This price shall be full compensation for furnishing all materials, marker preparation, installation, labor, equipment, tools and incidentals.
