



## NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING



### Loop 375 Extension Project

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) – El Paso District, in cooperation with the Camino Real Regional Mobility Authority (CRRMA), will host a public meeting, for the Loop 375 (Woodrow Bean/Transmountain Drive) Extension Project. The public meeting is scheduled on September 23, 2009 from 5:30 pm to 8:00 pm in the Lecture Forum at the El Paso Community College located at 9570 Gateway Blvd. North, El Paso, Texas. The Loop 375 Project from Dyer Street to US 54 (Patriot Freeway) will include the addition of two (2) mainlanes in each direction between the existing frontage roads. The project is proposed to include overpasses at Kenworthy Street, Rushing Road and Alcan Road, as well as a depressed roadway under the existing US 54 mainlanes and frontage roads. The project will connect to the existing Loop 375 mainlanes at Dyer and transition to the existing Transmountain Drive west of US 54.

The purpose of this public meeting is to present the proposed project and solicit feedback from the public. The public meeting will have an “open house” format with representatives from TxDOT and its consultant available in an informal setting to answer questions you may have about the project’s purpose and alternatives considered. A brief presentation of the main features of the project will be made at 6:00 pm. All interested persons are invited to attend this meeting to obtain information about the project and to express their views.
