

# SH 360 DETOUR TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN

**START:** November 5 8 p.m.  
**END:** November 8 5 a.m. (est)

**WHY:** To demolish the north half of the old Union Pacific Railroad bridge spanning SH 360 and to complete construction for the new Union Pacific Railroad bridge.

**WHAT:** SH 360 northbound and southbound mainlanes will be reduced to one lane and then detoured in advance of the SH 180/Division Street bridge.

SH 360 northbound traffic will exit at Abram Street. After exiting, traffic will be directed east along Abram Street to Great Southwest Parkway where motorists will cross the Union Pacific Railroad. Detoured motorists will use SH 180/Division Street to return to SH 360. In case of train activity, detour traffic will be directed to the next crossing at 23rd Street. The northbound SH 360 entrance ramp from Abram Street will also be closed during this time.

SH 360 southbound traffic will exit at SH 180/Division Street. After exiting, traffic will be directed west along SH 180/Division Street to Stadium Drive where motorists will cross the Union Pacific Railroad. Detoured motorists will use Abram Street to return to SH 360. In case of train activity, detoured motorists will be directed to the next crossing at Collins Street.
