I-35W public meeting April 3

FORT WORTH — All interested citizens are invited to attend an Interstate 35W public meeting Tuesday, April 3 from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Region XI Education Service Center located at 3001 North Freeway in Fort Worth. The “come and go” public meeting will discuss transportation improvements to I-35W from Interstate 30 to the Interstate 820 North Loop.

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting a corridor improvement study to evaluate a range of viable transportation alternatives along this section of the I-35W corridor. The goal of the study is to develop a locally preferred plan of action to alleviate congestion and improve mobility in the study area. The Regional Transportation Council (RTC) has identified this as a priority transportation corridor, but construction funding has not been identified. Gas-tax dollars available for the region are insufficient to cover the cost, but TxDOT and the RTC are aggressively pursuing other funding opportunities.

The public meeting will present the proposed improvements for the study area, and discuss the next steps in the study process. Maps, drawings and other information about the project will be on display, showing the location of the study corridor and suggested transportation alternatives. Interested citizens will have the opportunity to ask questions and offer written comments.
