

NOTICE AFFORDING OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC HEARING
Proposed Restriping of US 90
IH 10 to Mercury Drive
Harris County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) proposes to improve 0.45 mile of United States Highway (US) 90 from Interstate Highway (IH) 10 to Mercury Drive, in Harris County, Texas. The proposed project would restripe the four-lane facility to a six-lane facility. The purpose of the proposed project is to improve roadway conditions and mobility. The proposed project would restripe existing pavement, and no new pavement or right-of-way would be required. The proposed project is located inside the incorporated limits of the City of Houston.

Maps and other drawings showing the location of the project location and design, environmental studies, information about the relocation assistance program, and information about the tentative schedules for construction of the proposed improvements are available for inspection and copying at the at the TxDOT Houston district office located at 7600 Washington Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007.

No new right-of-way would be required for the proposed project. There are no anticipated displacements of residential, public, commercial, or industrial structures.

Anyone may request that a Public Hearing be held covering the social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this roadway project by delivering or mailing a written request on or before April 16, 2010.
