

## **Economically Disadvantaged Eligibility Criteria**

### **Plan Year 2006-2007**

To be considered economically disadvantaged, refer to the following income level guidelines.

The figures shown under family size and income levels, represent amounts equal to 225% of the family income levels established by the Census Bureau for determining poverty status. The poverty guidelines are based on data listed in the Federal Register, Vol. 71, No. 15, effective January 24, 2006 pp. 3848-3849.
