Public hearing schedule for I-27 project

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public hearing to present project plans and receive comments from the public on the proposed improvements to Interstate 27 (I-27) in the city of Plainview. The hearing will take place at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, January 23, 2012 in the LaMesa Elementary School gym located at 600 S. Ennis in Plainview.

An open-house will be held at 5 p.m., prior to the formal presentation. During the hearing, TxDOT personnel will present plans for converting the I-27 frontage roads from two-way to one-way, adding turnarounds, and reconfiguring ramps. Project limits are from FM 3466 to SH 194.

All interested persons are invited to attend this hearing and make comments.

Persons interested in attending this hearing who have special accommodation needs are encouraged to contact Heath Bozeman, P.E., TxDOT design engineer, at 806-293-5484, at least three days prior to the public hearing. Since the public hearing will be conducted in English, requests for language interpreters or other special individual needs should also be made at least three days prior to public hearing. The department will make every reasonable effort to accommodate these needs.
