




DISTRICT PROFILE

The Lufkin District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its nine counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and hazard elimination projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public.

MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- **US 59 North/Loop 287 Project (Lufkin)**
- Expansion of US 59 from the Moffett Rd. Overpass to FM 3439 - \$52 million (Est. completion date: Spring 2016)
- **US 59 South/Loop 224 Phase I (Nacogdoches County)**
- Construct raised medians and sidewalks from South of Spradley to SL 224
- Construct U-turns at Spradley Street near SL 224
- Widen medians and lanes at Spradley Street to accommodate future traffic
- Construction of US 59 main lanes
- Reconfigure the US 59/SL 224 intersection
- \$52 million (Est. completion date: Spring 2017)
- **US 84 (TX/LA State Line at Logansport, La.)**
- Sabine River Bridge Replacement
- \$20 million (Est. completion date: Spring 2017)

MAINTENANCE: The Lufkin District spends \$9 million annually on seal coat projects. It also spends several million each year rehabilitating roadways throughout the district.

CONSTRUCTION: In FY 2016, the district will spend more than \$84 million on construction projects district-wide, including \$5.23 million to replace two on-system bridges; \$10.27 million for the replacement of 28 off-system bridges; \$16.54 million safety treating fixed objects on nearly 200 miles of various roadways; and \$14.2 million for Prop I construction projects.

CORRIDORS: The Lufkin District's priority corridor effort is the development of I-69 either through the U.S. 59 Upgrade Option or New Location Option or a combination of both.
