




## DISTRICT PROFILE

The Laredo District plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in its counties. The district primarily conducts asset preservation and mobility projects to ensure the safety of the traveling public. The Laredo District experiences varying weather conditions to include extreme heat, which result in varying challenges for maintenance crews and designers in order to maintain district assets and assure the safety of the traveling public year-round.

### MAJOR PROJECTS UNDERWAY:

- State Loop 20/SP 400 Interchange (Webb County) – \$34 million
- State Loop 20 over KCS Railroad: new frontage roads and widening of existing bridge (Webb County) – \$25 million
- State Loop 20/International Boulevard Interchange (Webb County) – \$22 million

### PLANNED MAJOR PROJECTS:


- US 59 mainlanes (State Loop 20 at I-35 in Webb County) – \$36.5 million

**MAINTENANCE:** We spend \$20 million annually on seal coating projects and in-house operations. We also spend several million each year rehabilitating I-35 pavement.

**CORRIDORS:** The Laredo District's priority corridor efforts are I-35, US 59 (Loop 20/Future I-69W) and Ports to Plains (US 83 and US 277).

**SAFETY:** Safety projects total \$5.77 million to include traffic signal upgrades, rail upgrades, and texturing shoulders.
