RE: Entering VINs on Trailers in Vision 21-Dealer e-Tags
Correction to 5-6-2008 Memo

When you enter the new Vision 21 application for Dealer e-Tags you will note that a VIN is required to obtain a buyer's tag or a vehicle-specific dealer tag. We are aware that many utility trailers (less than 4,000 lbs) do not have VINS. A procedure has been implemented to address this issue for now.

In the field requesting a VIN, the dealer will enter the words "novin" along with the date & time. For example: **novin04052008341**. This would represent a no VIN trailer e-Tag transaction processed on 04/05/2008 at 3:41 pm.

The dealer still has the option of obtaining a VIN from the **VTR Regional Office** and imprinting that VIN on the trailer frame. This is actually the preferred method as it would permanently identify the trailer. At some time in the future, VINS will be required on all trailers.
