



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The El Paso District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a public hearing on Tuesday, November 16, 2010 at 4:00 p.m. at the Casner Room of Marfa City Hall, 113 South Highland Ave, Marfa, Texas.

The purpose of this hearing is to discuss the proposed El Paso District FY 2011-2014 rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for Brewster, Culberson, Hudspeth, Jeff Davis and Presidio Counties and to receive comments on the initial adoption. Area project status reports will be discussed as well.

The TIP is a four-year program of capital improvements for highway and transit projects. A list of proposed projects for Brewster, Culberson, Hudspeth, Jeff Davis, and Presidio Counties will be provided and discussed at the hearing.

Beginning Thursday, November 4, 2010, information about the TIP and proposed projects will be available for review and copying at the district office at 13301 Gateway Blvd. West, El Paso. This information will also be available at the Alpine Area Office located at 2400 North Highway 118 (Fort Davis Highway) in Alpine and at the following TxDOT maintenance offices: Dell City on FM 1437; Sierra Blanca at 700 FM 1111; Van Horn at 2001 Van Horn Dr. (US 90), 1.5 miles south of town; Fort Davis at 104 Musquiz Dr. (SH 118); Marfa at 809 West San Antonio (US 90); and Presidio on east FM 170.

All interested persons are encouraged to attend the public hearing. Oral and written comments from the public regarding the TIP and other programs and projects are requested and may be presented at the hearing. Written comments may be submitted as stated below. All comments received by Monday, November 29, 2010 will be considered in the decision making process and become part of the hearing records.
