




United States (US) Highway 190 From Farm to Market (FM) 2410 To FM 3470 (Stan Schlueter Loop)

Public Meeting

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting this public meeting to discuss proposed improvements to US 190 to enhance traffic flow and improve safety. The intent of tonight's public meeting is to inform the public of the proposed project and give the public an opportunity to comment on the project. The public is encouraged to speak to TxDOT staff one-on-one this evening and view the available exhibits of the project area.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Over the past ten years, plans to enhance traffic flow and improve safety along US 190 through the Killeen and Harker Heights area have been ongoing. TxDOT projects to improve access and traffic flow along US 190 have been constructed from Trimmier Rd to FM 3470 (Stan Schlueter) in Killeen on both the westbound and eastbound sides as well as from FM 3470 to FM 2410 (Knight's Way) in Harker Heights on the eastbound side. Work on US 190 from FM 2410 to Indian Trail is currently under construction.

PROPOSED PROJECT

TxDOT is developing plans for the next section of improvements from FM 2410 to FM 3470 on the westbound side of US 190. These improvements would consist of reversing the exit and entrance ramps and adding an auxiliary lane to the frontage road of westbound US 190. Other improvements would consist of improving the intersection at FM 3470 by providing additional turning lanes and an eastbound turnaround under the bridge. TxDOT is also proposing to improve two other intersections of FM 2410 at US 190 and at FM 3470. These intersection improvements would consist of widening pavement, restriping and signalization work for additional turn lanes.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

TxDOT is accepting written comments on these proposed improvements. All comments will be given full consideration. Please submit written comments tonight or mail them to the address below. Comments must be received by Friday, November 28, 2008.
