Texas Transportation Plan (TTP) 2040



The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will host a series of stakeholder workshops to solicit input to guide the development of the TTP 2040 – the State’s multi-modal, long-range transportation plan. The TTP 2040 will serve as TxDOT’s “blueprint” to guide collaborative planning efforts with our stakeholders in order to address the State’s transportation needs and accomplish the goals in TxDOT’s Strategic Plan. The TTP 2040 will include strategies for the development, construction, and implementation of projects and services for all transportation modes including roadways, aviation, public transportation, bicycle and pedestrian, waterways and coastal waters, and freight and passenger rail.
