1	3/18/2022	IS this contract for 1 or 2 years?	CORRECTION: This contract is set for 161 Working Days.
2	3/18/2022	It looks like the same RMC was bid out in October 2021. If it is the same, what is the reasoning for it being rebid?	This project was awarded at the October State Letting, however the Contractor failed to Execute citing Bid error.
3	3/19/2022	Are the 161 days consecutive?	This project is a standard work week charges. See Item 8.3.1.4 in the Standard Specifications for Construction and Maintenance of Highways, Streets and Bridges.
4	3/22/2022	This job is posted by the day 161 and mileage is 244. How we cover the difference whereas TXDOT says 1 mile per day.	Bid the job according to the plans. The number of crews are not stipulated in the general notes.
5	3/24/2022	Would a shorter measurement from the edge of pavement be established to avoid disturbing these tree areas and keep a uniform appearance or would TxDot require us to clear around them and hold the 30' specification?	Shorter distance established. We are planning to trim within a growth of trees. There will not be an expectation of brush removal beyond the established treeline.
6	3/30/2022	What is the estimated start date?	As soon as possible.
7	3/30/2022	I have read the specs but did not find anywhere saying that the miles listed are calculated by one side of the road or both. Could you please tell me if the 244 miles is calculated by both sides of the road are considered one mile or if one mile is just one side of the road.	Centerline miles measure the length of a road or highway regardless of number of lanes. Because of divergences and curves, centerline miles can vary slightly between the two sides of a divided highway. In other words, both sides of the roadway.
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
