1 9/30/2019	I have a question regarding Item (545-6016) CRASH CUSHION ATTEN(INSTALL)(R)(W) TL3. As stated in the general notes, all new installs must be MASH compliant. I don't see any in the Reusable category for wide units that meet MASH standards. Has there been one added that may not be listed on the standard sheets?	NCHRP 350 units will be allowed as long as the standard detail is available on our website or until a MASH approved unit type is available.
2 9/30/2019	On this contract, it shows 545 crash cushion items are to replace crash cushions with MASH compliant crash cushions. Why is this item needed if these are already covered with all the 774 remove and replace items? Trying to discern when you would use one over the other.	Item 545 requires a MASH compliant device, and will be used areas that do not require a specific CCA type or device, so long as it meets the requirements of the bid item. Item 774 requires specific replacement devices, some of which are not MASH compliant.
3 10/2/2019	I have read your response regarding Bid Item (545-6016)(R)(W) for the new installs. So, if I understand this correctly, an approved NCHRP 350 attenuator can be used for this item until a mash has been approved for this unit only? We can bid this item as NCHRP 350 unit but as soon as the Mash is released, I would be almost positive there would be a price increase, and if so, would the contractor be in a position to be able to adjust the price? At this point, there is no way to determine what those prices will be or what type of unit will be approved.	Should a MASH compliant item become available, the area office will discuss pricing and installation differences at that time
