1	<p>The plans for this project don't have a breakdown as to how many mowing cycles per year so I'll assume it is 3 with 12,000 total acres and the wording below from the plans.            12,000/4000/cycle yields 3 cycles. Also, there is usually a tract list with the number of acres per tract. Are you able to provide one, please?</p>	<p>That is correct, the contract is set-up for an initial 90 working days to include 3 cycles of 30 days each. Each cycle consists of approximately 4000 acres within the three counties stated in the general notes. Per the general notes, "The Department will issue a written notice to begin a mowing cycle. The Contractor will be provided the number of acres required to be mowed, the location of the acres to be mowed, the number of working days allowed to complete the mowing cycle, and the date when time charges for the mowing cycle will start" at the pre-work meeting.</p>
2	<p>The plans state 500 hours for the TMA. Which tracts will require a TMA?</p>	<p>Per the general notes "RS-TCP-05 standard shall be used during all mowing operations and TMAs in accordance with TCP standards will be required when directed by the Engineer." The inclusion of TMAs is intended to protect workers when directed by the Engineer to address safety concerns in any one of the three counties listed in the general notes.</p>
