| 1 | Can trees be mulched on-site? | 01/02/2020 | Yes, with prior approval from Engineer. |
| 2 | Where can we find all of the specific locations? | 01/02/2020 | The quantity summary table on sheet 4 of the plan set shows the location to be "Various". The intent of this contract is to remove dead or hazardous trees from the ROW. These locations are unknown at the time of the creation of the plan set. |
| 3 | Will we need to do a dig test? | 01/02/2020 | Please see the general notes under Item 752: Tree and Brush Removal. |
| 4 | Will there be power lines near the removal site(s)? | 01/02/2020 | Please see the general notes under Item 752: Tree and Brush Removal. |
| 5 | Under Item 752, it states that work should be completed between October 2nd and February 14th. What is the anticipated project start date? | 1/07/2020 | As stated in the General Notes, any work outside of these dates will only be emergency work. This contract is a call out contract. Also as stated in the General Notes, when there are a minimum of 10 trees to be removed, a work order will be issued. |
