1	How many miles of "Tree Trimming/Brush Removal" are in the contract?	09/10/2020	As shown on sheet 3 and 4 of the plans, 35 Miles of "Tree Trimming/Brush Removal" are included in this contract.
2	Do you have 1 Or 2 roadways that you will be working on for the tree trimming/brush removal?	09/10/2020	The "Various Locations" shown in the plans are to be used at the Maintenance Section Supervisor's discretion. The areas that need trimming will be determined and then discussed with the contractor at that time.
3	Will contactors be allowed to spread chips on ROW into this layer?	9/11/2020	Yes. The only exception is near culvert locations. The chips will have to be moved away from these locations. Coordination with the maintenance section is required for these locations.
4	Can I use either of these side trimming attachments for the job? see below, watch video	09/13/20	As shown on Sheet 2B, General Notes under Item 752 Tree and Brush Removal, trimming equipment must leave a "neat and uniform" appearance and no "boom-axe" will be allowed. This equipment must be approved by the Maintenance Supervisor.
5	Are mulchers allowed to be used in order to mulch on site?	9/15/20	Yes. The only exception is near culvert locations. The chips will have to be moved away from these locations. Coordination with the maintenance section is required for these locations.
6	Can we use boom saws, or side trimmers?	9/15/20	As shown on Sheet 2B, General Notes under Item 752 Tree and Brush Removal, trimming equipment must leave a "neat and uniform" appearance and no "boom-axe" will be allowed. This equipment must be approved by the Maintenance Supervisor.
