Per the General Notes, work will be scheduled at the discretion of the Maintenance Supervisor and/or Area Engineer responsible for that area by work order. For each cycle required a work order will be sent to the contractor containing the following information: - Type of mowing and total number of acres to be mowed - Working days allowed to complete the cycle - Date time charges for the cycle will begin The first work order is typically issued shortly after June 1st to allow enough time for the wildflowers to go to seed. Each contract awarded by the Department stands on its own and as such, is separate from the other contracts. A contractor awarded multiple contracts, must be capable and sufficiently staffed to concurrently process any or all contracts at the same time.

Per Item 8, the contractor will have 7 Calendar days after the authorization date (the work order) to begin work. Each of the mowing cycles will have a specific number of working days associated with it based on a production rate for that type of mowing as stated in the second to last paragraph in the General Notes for this contract.
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
