## SH 21 Relief Route Project

The Bryan District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), in coordination with the City of Madisonville, is reviewing alternative alignments for a relief route west of Madisonville, connecting SH 21 to IH 45. The proposed route would be on a new location and would require the acquisition of additional right of way. The purpose of this relief route would be to alleviate congestion through the community of Madisonville while increasing safety, connectivity, and mobility along the SH 21 corridor.

An informal open house is scheduled for Tuesday, July 22, 2014 between 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at the Truman Kimbro Convention Center. The alignment alternatives will be on display and TxDOT staff will be available to discuss the project. Since this is an open house format, no formal presentation is planned. Attendees may come and go at their convenience.
