

SH 36 Public Hearing US 290 to Business SH 36, in Brenham

The Bryan District of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will hold a public hearing to present proposed improvements to the intersection of SH 36 from US 290 to Business SH 36, in Brenham. The hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 9, 2014, at 6:00 p.m. at the Brenham Elementary School, 1000 West Blue Bell Road; Brenham, Texas. Project information, including a project location map, the planned layout and environmental study will be available for viewing by the public beginning at 5:00 p.m. prior to the formal hearing proceedings. These documents will also be available at the Bryan District Office at 2591 North Earl Rudder Freeway in Bryan. A brief presentation describing the project will be followed by an opportunity for public comments.

The Proposed Action would consist of adding capacity by widening SH 36 to a four lane divided facility from US 290 to Bus 36, a distance of 2.1 miles. The project would also include replacing the existing bridge over UPRR, Little Sandy Creek, Benton Drive, and Lounge Road to bring it up to current design standards. Two new bridges would be constructed for northbound and southbound traffic. The proposed project would also include two lane curb and gutter frontage roads with an entrance and exit ramp west of the bridges and a U-turn under the bridge on the west side.

No additional right-of-way will be required to accommodate the improvement. There would be no relocation of homes or businesses.

The placement of temporary or permanent dredge or fill material into potentially jurisdictional waters of the U. S. would be authorized under NWP 14 without a Pre-Construction Notification (PCN).

All interested citizens are invited to attend this hearing. Comments may be presented at the hearing or in writing to Mr. Chad L.
