Why State Highway (SH) 249 Improvements are Needed

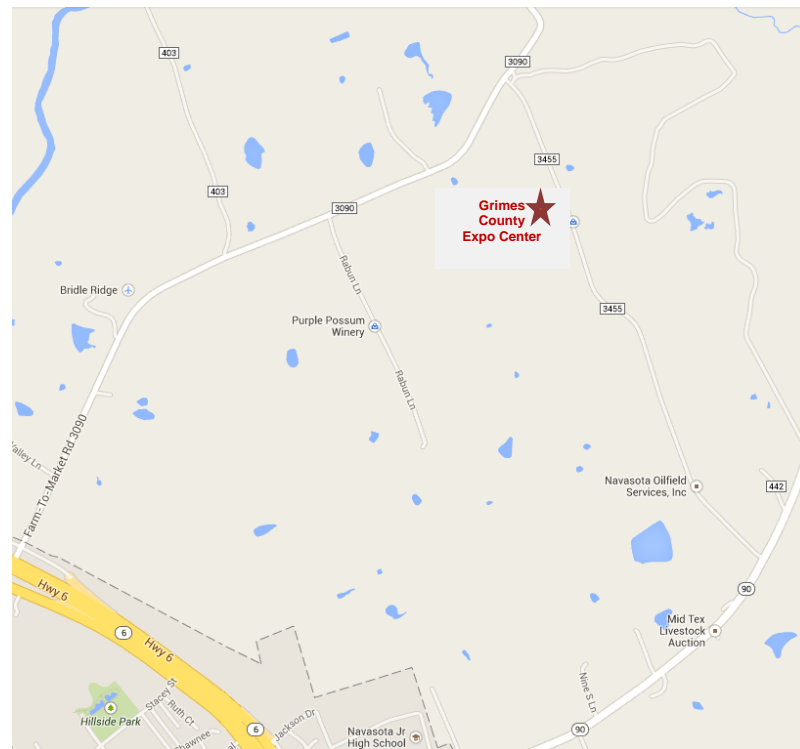
The proposed construction is intended to improve safety, reduce existing and future traffic congestion, improve transportation system linkage and provide an emergency evacuation route.

Meeting Purpose

The previous SH 249 Grimes County open house last October presented the recommended study area for the proposed construction of SH 249 from FM 1774 to SH 105 in Grimes County. The purpose of this open house meeting is to provide information and gather public input on the proposed project, which includes constructing a new two-lane roadway with a passing lane in alternating directions and shoulders within a right of way that would accommodate future widening to a four-lane divided roadway. TxDOT staff will present six alternatives and will share the recommended alternative, a new roadway that will require approximately 400 acres of right of way; no relocations are required.

The public is encouraged to attend this meeting and provide comments any time on or before April 18, 2014.
