



Notice of Public Meeting: FM 45 from Brown County Line to San Saba County Line

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) in cooperation with Mills County will hold a public meeting regarding proposed improvements to FM 45. The proposed improvements begin at the Brown County Line and end at the San Saba County Line in Mills County. The proposed project would include realignment and widening of FM 45 to accommodate two 12-foot lanes with 8-foot shoulders. The meeting will be held on:

The meeting will be conducted in an Open House come-and-go format with no formal presentation. The meeting will begin at 5 p.m. and end at 7 p.m. Project staff will be available to answer questions about the proposed project. Project exhibits, environmental documentation, maps, and design drawings will be available for review during the meeting. In addition, this information, along with the tentative schedule for construction, is available by appointment for review and copying at the TxDOT Brownwood District Office, 2495 Highway 183 North, Brownwood, Texas 76802.

All interested citizens are invited to attend this meeting. TxDOT offices are open Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., excluding state holidays.
