O. Trevino and Austin Bridge & Road

When President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act in February, Texas was poised to receive \$2.6 billion for highway, bridge and transit projects around the state. And immediately, TxDOT began putting that money to use on mobility and maintenance projects that would improve the safety of the state transportation system, leverage or pool resources, and create long-term economic benefit to the communities and regions they serve.

A beneficiary of those stimulus dollars has been O. Trevino Construction. A 20-year construction company based in Roanoke, O. Trevino has worked as a prime and subcontractor on several TxDOT projects.

A Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE)-certified company, O. Trevino will work on two stimulus-funded projects this year as a subcontractor to Austin Bridge & Road: resurfacing State Highway 114 in Dallas and replacing bridges in Ellis County.

“We currently have \$8.9 million worth of ARRA contracts or subcontracts,” O. Trevino Vice-President Pat Pace said. “Had we not picked up the work...we would have had to evaluate our work load and adjust our crews accordingly.”

The extra work is welcome news to the construction industry. While the ARRA funds helped the construction industry maintain its market, the program also helped avoid potential layoffs, according to Austin Bridge & Road Director of Communications Misti Mitteis.

Austin Bridge & Road is also the prime contractor on three ARRA-funded projects, with two of the projects contracted through TxDOT at a value of \$3.8 million. The third project, estimated at \$33.44 million, is contracted through the Louisiana Department of Transportation and Development.

“[The creation of ARRA-funded projects] gives us more targets to bid...and could avoid a slowdown [in the industry],” O. Trevino’s Pace said.

But that stability to the industry came at a price: more paperwork. According to Pace, the federal government requires extensive tracking of the funds.

“With ARRA work, you have a lot more information you need to gather to tell a story of how you did the job, with what person, at what time, with what equipment. The work itself stays the same, though,” Pace said.

And while the stimulus dollars filled a void, contractors and subcontractors say they’re up to the challenge for more work.

The key towards increasing growth for today’s construction companies, Mitteis said, is to simply let more work and create more projects. But even that is not without its challenges.

Over the next two years, TxDOT’s letting totals will increase, primarily because of stimulus funding and additional borrowing, but both are short-term fixes to the state’s larger problem of future decreasing revenues.

“The true changes need to be made at the legislative level to decrease diversions, index the gas tax, and come up with a reliable funding source for the expansion and maintenance of our highways in Texas,” Pace said.

But until Texas has more permanent solutions, the state will continue to make the best use of the funding programs that are available. And for contractors in TxDOT’s DBE program, stimulus dollars have met their goal of getting projects on the ground and putting people to work.

Of the \$46.98 million paid to date on ARRA projects, more than \$3.5 million has gone to DBEs like O. Trevino Construction. For TxDOT’s DBE program, that means that more than 132 program participants are benefitting from the stimulus program.

FEDs Announce New Bond Fee Reimbursement Program

WASHINGTON - U.S. Transportation Secretary Ray LaHood announced \$20 million in recovery funds to create the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Bonding Assistance Program, an initiative that will help small and disadvantaged businesses better compete for work on transportation projects funded by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA).

Through this new program, which will be administered by the Department of Transportation's Office of Small and Disadvantaged Business Utilization (OSDBU), small and disadvantaged businesses can apply to be reimbursed for bonding premiums and fees incurred when competing for, or performing on, transportation infrastructure projects funded by ARRA.

The program will be especially helpful for businesses with traditionally less working capital than larger contractors.

"The Obama Administration is committed to doing all it can to help DBEs realize the American dream and contribute to making our transportation systems even better," said Secretary LaHood. "These Recovery dollars will help level the playing field so these companies have the tools and resources they need to compete."

OSDBU was created as part of the Small Business Act (SBA) to ensure that small and disadvantaged businesses are provided the best opportunity to participate in the agency's contracting process. DOT's Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program is intended to ensure nondiscrimination in the award and administration of DOT-assisted contracts in the department's highway, transit, airport, and highway safety financial assistance programs. To be certified as a DBE, a firm must be a small business owned and controlled by socially and economically disadvantaged individuals.

New TAP Program

In an attempt to better serve the needs and interests of Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) across Texas, TxDOT's Business Outreach Program recently unveiled its newly redesigned Technical Assistance Program (TAP) in June 2009. This program is designed to provide eligible DBEs with up to \$10,000 of free training and technical assistance in a variety of business development and construction categories. The goal of TAP is to improve the business capacity of each DBE and thereby increasing the number of minority contractors bidding and performing on TxDOT highway construction contracts.

Along with a clearer distinction between training and technical assistance, a DBE Needs Assessment is now required from all DBEs in an effort to better evaluate business development and technical assistance needs. The DBE Needs Assessment is required for all companies interested in receiving training through TAP. A "TAP Overview" presentation will soon be downloadable for each prospective DBE client to view and become familiar with the program. These program changes are aimed at increasing communication among DBEs, providers and TxDOT with the ultimate goal of serving each company's training needs more effectively and efficiently.

Categories of Training include: Construction, Financial Management, Business Management, Computer Training, Environmental Document Compliance and Communication Skills. Categories of Technical Assistance include: Bonding, Business Management, Computer Technical Assistance and Financial Packages. In spite of their diversity, all these categories are united by one overarching goal: to better train and prepare DBEs to become successful bidders on TxDOT contracts.

Each of these different topics are provided by contracted "Technical Assistance Providers" that specialize in their respective category.

What is the LINC program?

The LINC program is a mentor-protégé program to prepare small businesses to bid and perform on Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) contracts as sub-contractors, or prime contractors.

In this program, TxDOT is the mentor to small businesses interested in doing business with TxDOT. Through a series of meetings, protégés learn about TxDOT's business opportunities, and receive information to assist them in bidding and performing on TxDOT's contracts.

LINC mentors introduce the protégés to key TxDOT staff and prime contractors and provide networking opportunities with those individuals. LINC mentors facilitate collaboration between the protégés and TxDOT district staff, technical assistance provider, bonding agents and trainers.

Who qualifies for the LINC program?

Small businesses that perform a category of work, or supply a type of service that TxDOT routinely procures.

How will the LINC program benefit my company?

- ☆ You will be assigned a TxDOT mentor to assist you throughout the program.
- ☆ You will receive information on how to do business with TxDOT.
- ☆ You will receive business development and technical industry training.
- ☆ You will be given an opportunity to meet and market your firm to key TxDOT personnel and prime contractors.
- ☆ You will be included in the LINC bulletin which is circulated to prime contractors and TxDOT personnel staff.
- ☆ A marketing presentation and customized portfolio will be developed for your firm.
- ☆ You will receive information on:
 - how to pre-qualify as a prime contractor;
 - how to search for contracts on TxDOT's Internet Web site;
 - how to find plans on line.
