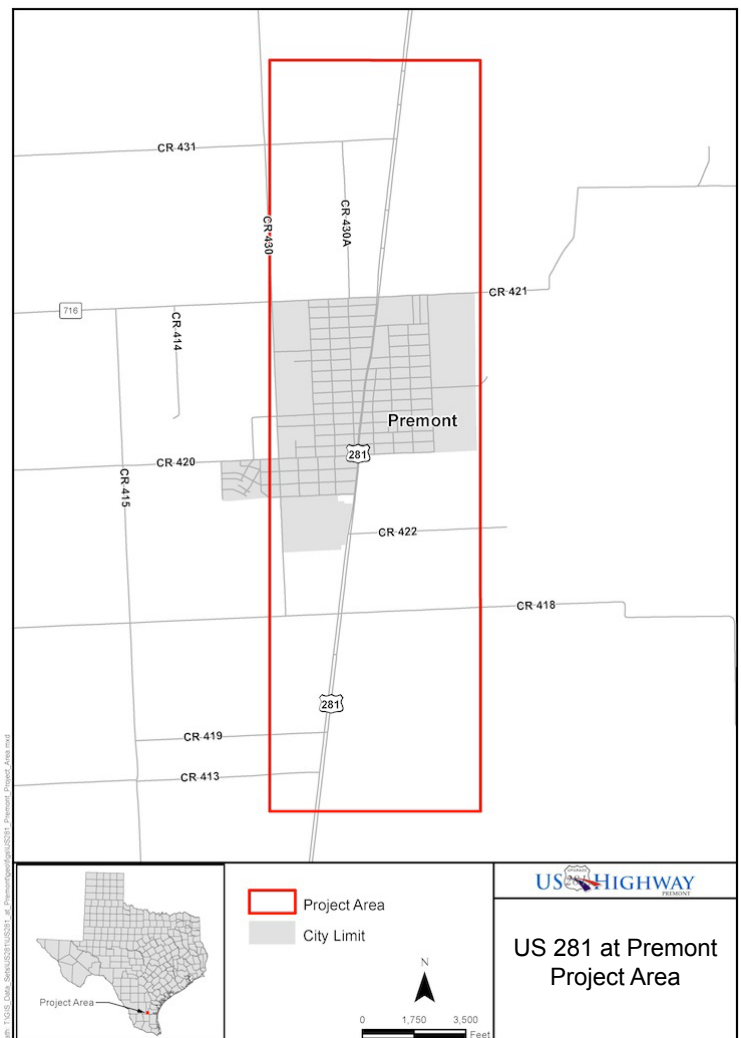

The study area extends from just south of CR 413 to north of CR 431 and from approximately CR 430 on the west to just outside the City of Premont city limits on the east. Overall, the study area is approximately 4.8 miles long by approximately 1.3 miles wide and is entirely within Jim Wells County.

An access controlled relief route for the City of Premont is being considered. The purpose of the proposed project is to upgrade US 281 at Premont to meet current interstate design standards and improve the safety of the traveling public, in a manner that is sensitive to the environment and serves the access and mobility needs of the community.
