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


Subject: Value of Delay Time and Road User Costs

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Road User Costs are the values used in A + B bidding, incentives/disincentives for milestones, final substantial completion, lane rentals, and additional project-specific liquidated damages (APSLD).

Each year TxDOT adjusts the value of time used in calculations for determining Road User Costs. The adjustment is based on the annual Consumer Price Index for the previous year. The value of delay time to be used in the calculations for 2021, as determined by The University of Texas at Austin Center for Transportation Research, is \$30.54 per passenger car hour and \$41.91 per commercial truck hour.
