OVERVIEW

The project is located on SH 114 in Denton County, east of I-35W to BUS 114K. Work includes the construction of new 6-lane freeway and the reconstruction of the eastbound frontage road.

The purpose and need of the project is to improve mobility and bring the roadway up to current design standards. The proposed project is needed to meet future travel demands stemming from projected population growth and traffic volumes.

- **Project Limits:** I-35W to US 377
- **Highway:** SH 114
- **Estimated Cost:** \$99 million
- **Contractor:** Mario Sinacola & Son Excavating Inc.
- **Project Details:** Construct new highway lanes in median area and rebuild eastbound frontage road

- **Work began:** Summer 2023

- **Estimated Date of Completion:** Jan. 2026

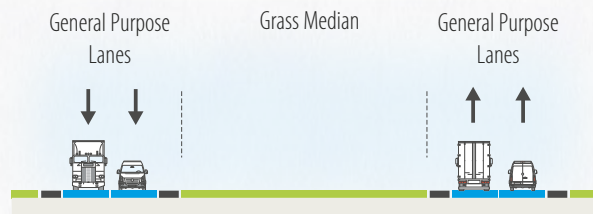

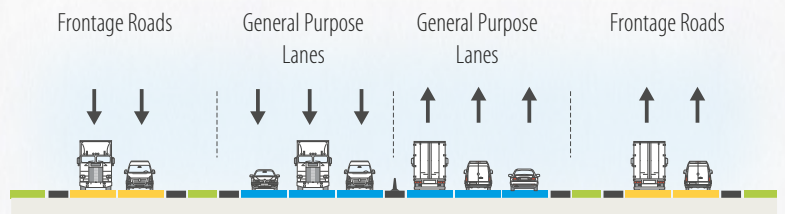
