

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING  
I-10 Mesa Park Interchange Project

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), El Paso District, will conduct a Public Meeting for the proposed I-10 Mesa Park Interchange project on:

The purpose of the meeting is to provide information about the proposed project and gather input from the public. The proposed interchange project is the construction of an interchange on I-10 for proposed Mesa Park Drive north of Executive Center Blvd. These improvements provide operational improvement to the I-10 facility and surrounding streets. The project will be constructed within existing right-of-way with no relocations or displacements. There may be minor amounts of additional right-of-way needed for corner clips at the Mesa Park Drive intersection.

The Public Meeting will be conducted in an open house format. Those wishing to attend are encouraged to do so at their convenience between the hours of 5:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. Maps of the project area and other displays will be available for review and comment. TxDOT staff will be available to answer questions. All material will be presented in English and Spanish. No formal presentation will be given. Parking will be available in the school parking lot.

TxDOT will make all reasonable efforts to accommodate other special needs as requested.
