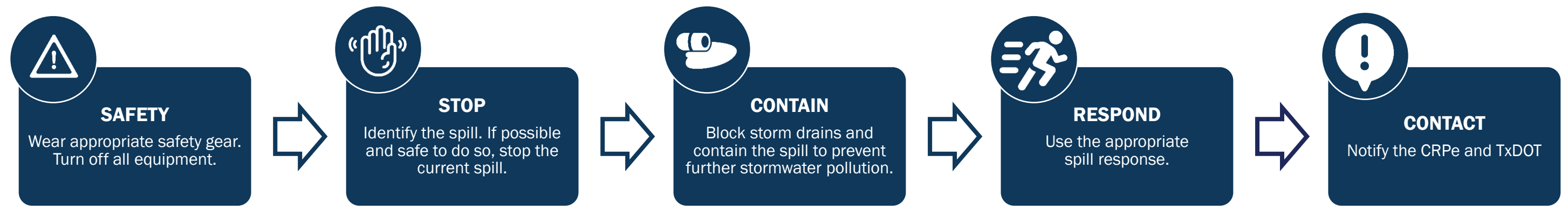

Detailed Spill Cleanup and Storm Drain Protection

1. Quickly stop the spill. This may require uprighting a container or patching a hole.
2. For larger spills, place a sock berm or barrier around the spill to prevent further contamination.
3. Protect storm inlets with a berm, dike, cover, or absorbent sock.
4. Soak up liquids with items from the spill kits. This may include mats, kitty litter, or absorbent pads.
5. Sweep or pick up the material.
6. Put all spill material in a secure container.
7. Refer to the SDS for waste disposal procedures.
8. Note where the spill has leaked onto any grass, soil, gravel, or water.
9. Record the spill in the spill log.
10. Notify the contractor of the spill for further clean-up and notification and reporting to TCEQ or Fish and Wildlife.

Common Spills May Include:

- Fuel
- Diesel
- Chemicals
- Paints/Solvents
- Pesticides/Herbicides
- Fluid or oil from vehicle

DO call 911 if the spill is harmful to human life or is flammable

DO protect storm drain inlets

DO report the spill to the CRPe & TxDOT

DON'T put yourself in danger

DON'T hose down spills or leaks
