



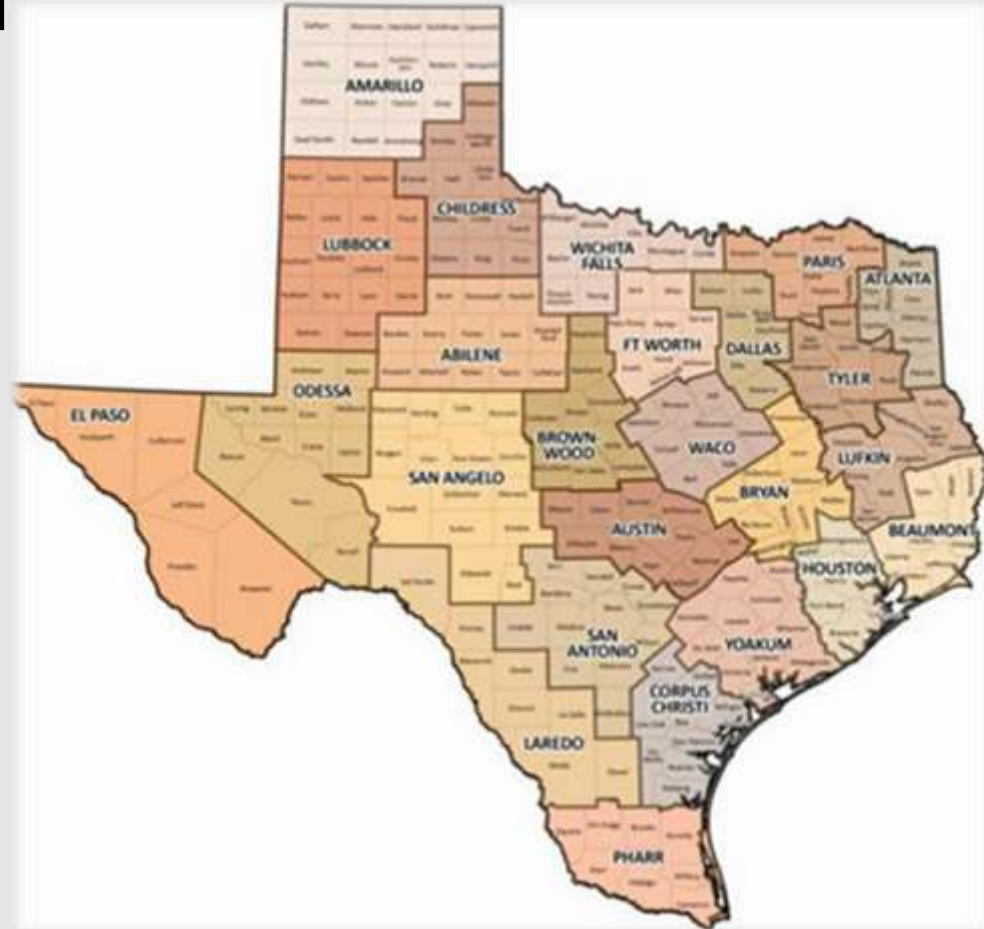
TXDOT - OVERVIEW

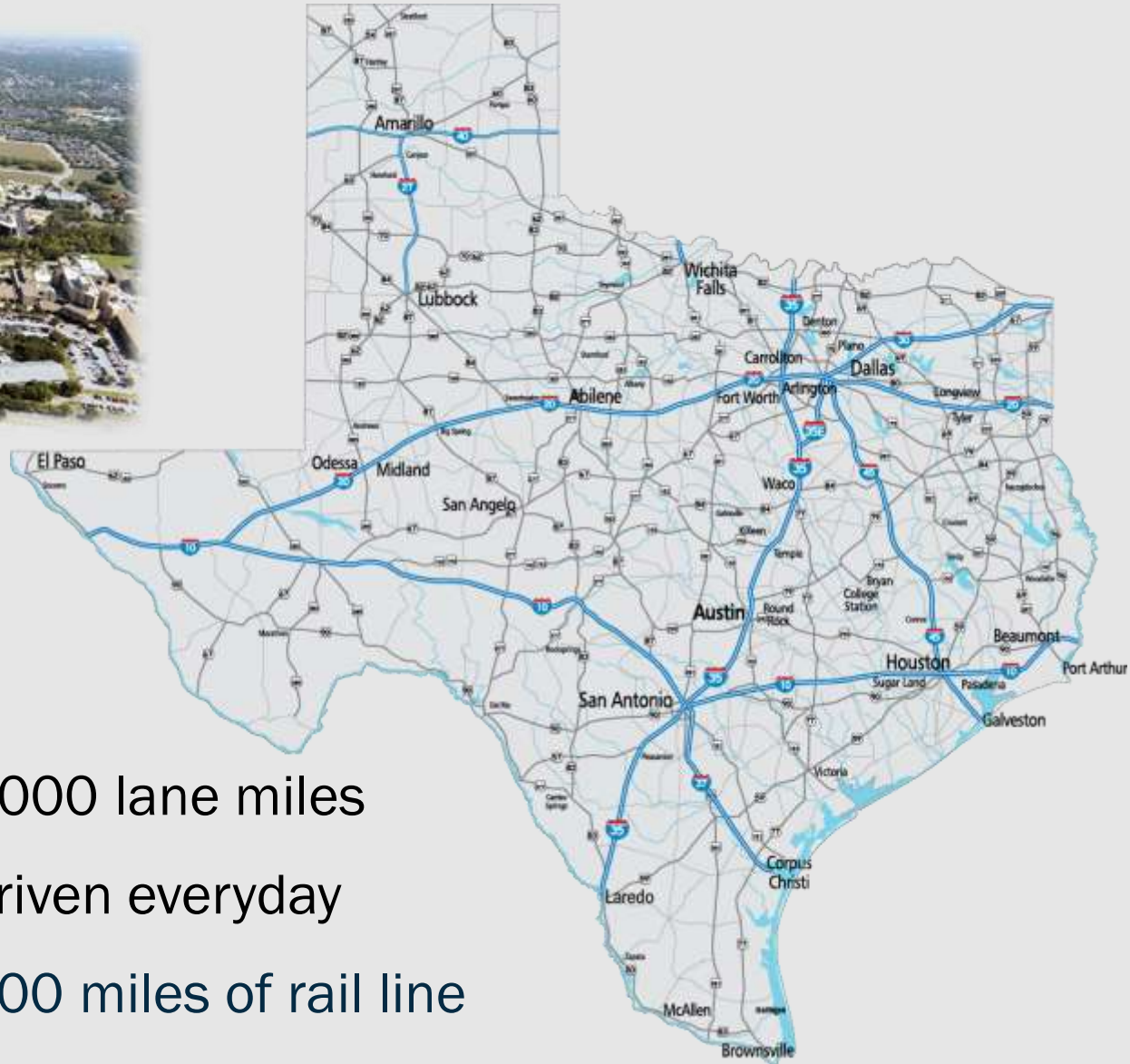

Mission: Through collaboration and leadership, we deliver a safe, reliable, and integrated transportation system that enables the movement of people and goods.



- Headquartered in Austin, TxDOT is organized by administration, districts and divisions
 - Our 25 districts plan, design, build, operate and maintain state highways in their respective districts
 - Our 32 divisions handle a diverse range of services for the agency, including construction, design, bridge, rail, maritime, and environmental affairs





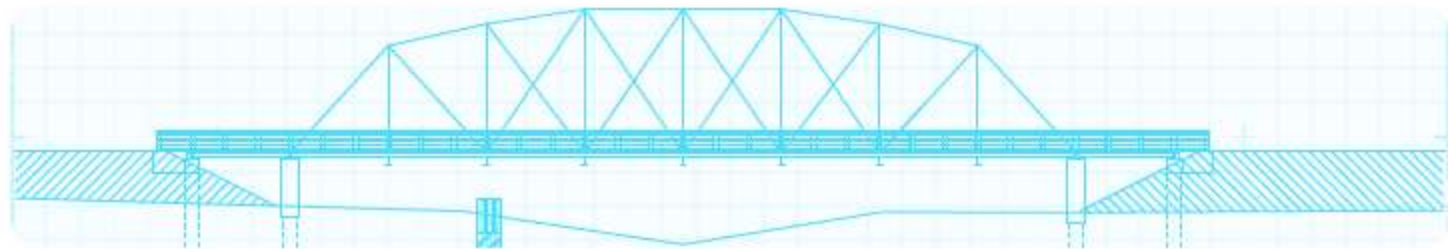
- Texas maintains 195,000 lane miles
 - 515 million miles driven everyday
- Texas maintains 10,000 miles of rail line



- Texas has 11 deep-draft (channel depth of greater than 30 feet) and 6 shallow-draft (channel depth of less than 30 feet) commercial ports
 - Ranked 2nd in the nation for waterborne commerce



- Texas has 54,180 bridges, about 26,000 more than any other state in the nation
 - 27 international bridges between Mexico and Texas



Calendar Year 2017

- ~14 bridge permit requests initiated
- ~20 exceptions requests initiated
 - The majority of the exceptions included a bridge lighting exemption request
