

## NOTICE AFFORDING THE OPPORTUNITY FOR A PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Weatherford in conjunction with the Texas Department of Transportation is proposing to construct new eastbound and westbound frontage roads and ramp realignments in the City of Weatherford, Parker County, Texas. The limits of the project are from 0.2 miles west of South Bowie Drive to F.M. Highway 1884 (Bethel Road). The total distance of the proposed project is approximately 0.903 miles.

The proposed project will construct a new one-way westbound frontage road and realign and extend the existing two-way eastbound frontage on IH 20 between South Bowie Drive and FM Highway 1884. Both frontage roads will be a one-way operation. The proposed project will also relocate the existing westbound and eastbound exit and entrance ramps.

Approximately 0.11 acre (4,792 sq. ft.) of new ROW and 0.02 acre (871 sq. ft.) of permanent easement would be required for the proposed project. The environmental document, project location map, drawings and other information about the project are available for inspection and copying at:

Any interested citizen may request a public hearing covering the social, economic and environmental effects of the proposed location and design for this project. Requests for a public hearing must be submitted in writing on or before April 24, 2013, to Maribel P. Chavez, P.E., TxDOT Fort Worth District Engineer, 2501 SW Loop 820, Fort Worth, Texas 76133. If such a request is received, a public hearing will be scheduled. Adequate notice will be published to announce the date and location of the hearing.

If you have general questions or concerns regarding the proposed project, you may contact Mr. Terry Hughes with the City of Weatherford or Mr. John Cordary with TxDOT in lieu of requesting a public hearing. If these questions are not answered to your satisfaction, a public hearing should be requested.
