Project Need and Purpose

What are we trying to do?

- Improve mobility for vehicles and pedestrians within the project limits

What problems are we trying to address?

- Traffic congestion is expected to worsen
- Growth of The University of Texas San Antonio (UTSA)



What is Being Proposed?



- **From Babcock Road to UTEX Boulevard:** Expand from a 2-lane roadway to 4-lane roadway with curb, storm sewer, and pedestrian and bicycle accommodations.
- **From UTEX Boulevard to IH 10:** Existing 4 lanes - re-stripe existing outside lane to serve as shared use lane, and add sidewalk on south side of roadway.
- Provide medians from Babcock Road to Edward Ximenes Avenue.
- Improvements would require additional right-of-way and an easement.
- Total project length is 2.35 miles.
