





PROJECT BACKGROUND

US 190 is part of the National Highway System and the Texas Trunk System. The purpose of the project is to improve road conditions for through and local traffic. Additional travel lanes and grade separation are needed to increase safety and to meet the demands of current and future growth in the area.

PURPOSE OF PUBLIC MEETING

The purpose of tonight's public meeting is to present the preferred design that has been refined as a result of environmental and engineering constraints. Tonight's public meeting also gives the public the opportunity to comment on the proposed project. TxDOT personnel will be available one-on-one to receive comments and answer questions prior to and after the formal presentation. Project schematics will be available for viewing by the public. Written comments about the proposed project will be accepted at the meeting. Additionally, written comments may be mailed to Albin A. (Andy) Petter, P.E., Director of Transportation Planning and Development, Texas Department of Transportation, 100 South Loop Drive, Waco, TX 76704.

Questions will be addressed after the conclusion of the formal presentation by TxDOT officials on a one on one basis.

PROPOSED PROJECT

The project would widen the existing divided roadway from four to six main lanes and realign and widen existing frontage roads. Additional relocations of entrance and exit ramps would also occur. New overpasses and significant changes at and along major cross street connections would be included in this project. Additional right-of-way is proposed at various locations throughout the limits of the project. The proposed project would require possible displacement of residences and businesses.

- Environmental Clearance – Mid 2010
- Begin Right-of-Way Acquisition – (Pending Environmental Clearance and Funding)
- Begin Construction – (Pending Right-of-Way Acquisition, Utility Adjustments and Availability of Funding)
