


# Dallas-Fort Worth Multimodalism










## ■ Dallas District

- Plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in seven counties: Collin, Dallas, Denton, Ellis, Kaufman, Navarro and Rockwall
- Encompasses 5,447 square miles
- Lane miles of state system roadways: 10,426
- Serves approximately 4.2 million people
- Approximately 3.7 million registered vehicles
- Current full-time employee count: 822
- Five area offices and six maintenance offices

## ■ Fort Worth District


- Plans, designs, builds, operates and maintains the state transportation system in nine counties: Erath, Hood, Jack, Johnson, Palo Pinto, Parker, Somervell, Tarrant and Wise.
- Encompasses 6,949 square miles
- Lane miles of state system roadways: 8,870
- Serves approximately 2.3 million people
- Approximately 2.1 million registered vehicles
- Current full-time employee count: 564
- Six area offices and six maintenance offices




# Future Projects and Congestion Management

DETAIL MAP




