

## Project Overview

### Improving Traffic Flow on SH 121 between Grapevine and Bedford/Euless

Traffic congestion on SH 121 has grown substantially over the past decade, especially during peak travel times. As an interim step to a longer-term solution, the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and its regional partners have reconstructed the inside shoulder to accommodate motorists and improve traffic flow during peak travel times.

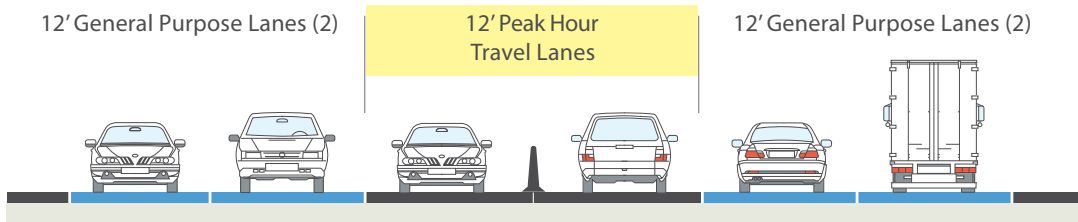
- Generally speaking, the shoulder from Glade Road to Harwood Drive is now a travel lane during assigned operating hours (Monday through Friday, 5:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.).
- This provides three lanes in both directions.
- The sign above the lane indicates when the inside shoulder is open for use. When not open for use, the inside shoulder will remain available for emergencies and disabled vehicles.

**Note:** This lane is not a toll lane; rather, it's available for commuters to use during the designated times. This lane opens for service in early December 2020.

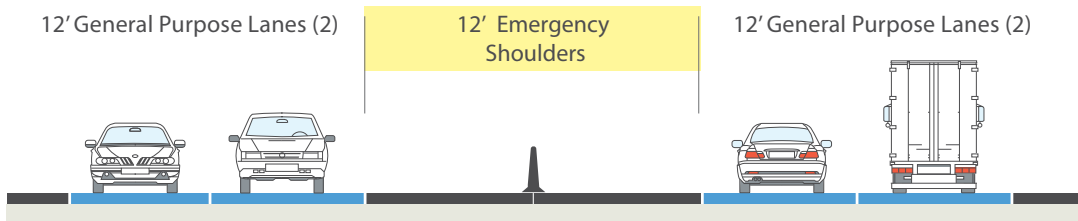
