



Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Option 2027-2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Abilene District

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Abilene District will conduct a virtual public meeting with an in-person option for the 2027–2030 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (Rural TIP). The purpose of this meeting is to provide information and receive comments on which transportation projects may be coming to your area. The Abilene District includes Borden, Callahan, Fisher, Haskell, Howard, Jones, Kent, Mitchell, Nolan, Scurry, Shackelford, Stonewall and Taylor counties. The Rural TIP includes both grouped projects and individually listed projects that include added-capacity projects and regionally significant projects to be funded outside of MPO boundary, and within a TxDOT district during the next four years, including those eligible for federal funding. This meeting offers the public an opportunity to review and comment on the proposed priorities. The Rural TIP is the first step on the road to producing a Statewide Transportation Improvement Program (STIP).

The same information, including a short presentation, exhibits explaining how the Rural TIP operates, and projects that are included in it, will be available to view during both the virtual and in-person public meetings.

All community members are encouraged to attend the public meeting and provide written comments on the proposed program.
