2023 - 2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program Revision Abilene District November 2023 Revision

The Texas Department of Transportation's (TxDOT) Abilene District is conducting a virtual meeting beginning Monday, Oct. 16, 2023, at 9 a.m. The purpose of this meeting is to provide updates and receive comments on proposed revisions to the 2023-2026 Rural Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). The projects in TxDOT's Abilene District affected by the revision include adding:

- CSJ: 0034-01-130, US 83/84 'Y' interchange, Taylor County, Construct grade separated interchange at US 83/84 intersection.
- CSJ 0034-02-044, US 83 5-Lane section, Taylor County, widen road to five lanes from CR 160 to US 84

The 2021-2024 Rural TIP meeting(s) was held in the Spring of 2022 pursuant to *Title 43, Texas Administrative Code, Section 16.102*, which calls for an opportunity for public comment concerning the program. As a continuation of the public involvement effort, the online comment opportunity will offer the public a chance to comment on the revision to the previously presented Rural TIP.
