

# US 87 Howard and Glasscock Counties

From 2 miles north of Glasscock County line to 0.45 mile south of Howard County line

## Project Overview

**Length:** Approximately 2.45 miles

**Authorized Construction Funds:** \$16,240,000 (Howard County) and \$3,584,000 (Glasscock County)

## Project Description

TxDOT is proposing to improve the existing US 87 from a five-lane undivided highway to a four-lane divided highway that meets interstate standards. The proposed project would construct the ultimate four-lane divided roadway with two access-controlled mainlanes in each direction, frontage roads on both sides of the roadway and diamond interchanges with turnarounds at intersections. The proposed roadway would become a future part of the Interstate Highway 27 section in the Ports-to-Plains Corridor.

## Proposed Improvements

- 12-foot-wide mainlanes with 10-foot-wide inside and outside shoulders
- Mainlanes separated by 10-foot-wide inside shoulders and 4-foot center median with single concrete safety barrier
- One-way two-lane frontage roads with 12-foot-wide lanes and 4-foot-wide inside shoulders and 10-foot-wide outside shoulders
- Diamond interchanges with turnarounds at FM 821, FM 461 W, and FM 461 E
- Frontage roads would be built first and remaining elements completed later, subject to construction funding
