



**Notice of Virtual Public Meeting with In-Person Options
Business I-40 (Amarillo Boulevard) Pedestrian Improvements
From Southwest Ninth Avenue to North Hughes Street

Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Amarillo District is proposing improvements to pedestrian facilities along Business I-40 (Amarillo Boulevard) in Potter County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will conduct a virtual public meeting on the proposed project with two in-person options. **The virtual meeting will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation and will include both audio and visual components. The presentation will be posted online by 2 p.m. Thursday, May 7 and will remain online for at least 15 days.** To view the virtual public meeting, visit txdot.gov at the date and time indicated above, Keyword Search: "BI-40 Pedestrian Improvements". If you do not have internet access, you may call 806-356-3200 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process.

Additionally, TxDOT is providing two in-person options for individuals who prefer to participate in person instead of online. The in-person options will be held in a traditional public meeting format. Attendees can view a brief presentation that will begin within the first 30 minutes of each in-person public meeting opportunity, review hard copies of project materials, ask questions of TxDOT staff, and leave written comments. **The in-person options will be held Thursday, May 7, 2026, from 2 to 4 p.m. and again from 6 to 8 p.m. at Amarillo College, West Campus Lecture Hall, 6222 SW 9th Ave. Amarillo, TX 79106.**

Planned work consists of pedestrian improvements along Business I-40, including ADA compliant shared-use paths, and signal improvements at Southwest 9th Avenue, North Western Street, and North McMasters Street. Any environmental documentation or studies, any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are on file and available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at 5715 Canyon Dr., Amarillo, TX 79110, or by calling 806-356-3200. Project

materials are also available online at txdot.gov, Keyword Search: BI-40 Pedestrian Improvements. These materials will also be available in hard copy form for review at the in-person options.

The virtual public meeting and in-person options will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a disability who requires accommodation to attend and participate in the virtual public meeting or in-person option, please contact Jason Britsch, Amarillo District public information officer, at 806-356-3256 no later than 4 p.m. CT, on Thursday, May 4, 2026. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the TxDOT to arrange.

Responses to comments received will be available on the public meeting page on txdot.gov once they have been prepared.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable Federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried-out by TxDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C. 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated July 17, 2025, and executed by FHWA and TxDOT.
